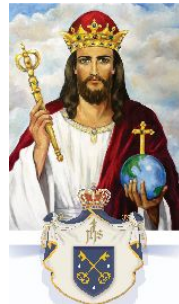

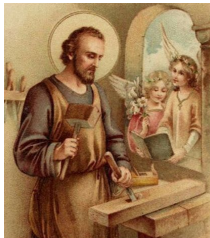

Thank you for your continued donations to our building project, “*Do This in Memory of Me.*”

We now have our building architect, Carmine Carapella, under contract and the first payment has been made. A second contract with our site plan architect, Cavoli Engineering, is being finalized. Things are moving forward!

Our building architect will have final drafts by October. Meanwhile, Fr Huber and I will likely begin seeing some of you about making a three-year pledge towards our goal *showing you our current preliminary plans and four-phase development* (which I have already discussed here.)

Again, these are preliminary plans, final drafts not expected until October, but the new church design plan & placement will not change.

For those new to CtK, please know about two years ago, Christ the King began looking into accommodating its growing attendance at its Sunday Masses. (On this feast day, in 2019, at two Masses, CtK had 254 souls attend; on the same feast, in 2023, at three Masses, 437 souls attended; a 72% increase.) An ad hoc building committee was formed, meetings were held, and it was determined CtK’s 3-acre parcel was limited to a 400-seat church and a decision was made to simply expand our current chapel. Last year, the diocese accepted this proposal & a capital campaign began.

Early this year, however, that plan was revisited and Fr Hathaway, with the approval of a now formal building committee, agreed that a new building, situated perpendicular to the social hall, would offer more benefits e.g., a new building will allow us to better express our perennial faith & appear more integral than a patchwork add-on; have new electrical & plumbing systems, avoiding problems tying into our old failing system; be in the center of our property, symbolizing God’s place in our lives, which will preserve our liturgy from Encore noise. (Such themes are expressed in our campaign prayer to St Joseph on the back of this bulletin.) Last spring, CtK’s building committee & architect obtained diocesan approval to go forward with this new plan which brings us to the current day.

Finally, please know that Fr Huber and I firmly support this project both for current needs and for the future as well; as some proof, we will individually pledge one year’s salary (over three years) in support of “*Do This in Memory of Me.*” Will you help us? Your donations now will be assumed into any financial request we may eventually ask of you. God bless you,
