With this offering, I would like to make the offering of all my day's thoughts, words, and deeds, and I pray Mary make these pleasing to Thee Who art all good and deserving of all my love.

I also desire to gain all the indulgences and merits that I can this day and I ask that these be offered up to the Immaculate Heart of Mary so that she may distribute these to the needs of Thy Most Sacred Heart. Amen.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I give you my heart, my mind, and my soul.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, be with me in my last agony.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, grant me thy peace.

Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, I love you very much and I beg you to spare the life of the unborn child whom I have spiritually adopted.

### **For wearers of Miraculous Medal**

O Mary, conceived without sin, pray for us who have recourse to Thee. 3X

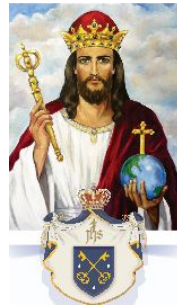
### **To obtain purity**

One Our Father & followed by three Hail Marys, with each Hail Mary being preceded by a petition such as, "Mary, my mother in heaven, today I ask that you keep my body pure & my soul holy."

**Pray for others especially the Pope, cardinals, bishops, priests, missions, public leaders. Then pray - by name - for family, relatives, friends and end saying,** and I pray for all those who have asked for my prayers, who I said I would pray for, who need prayers and have no one to pray for them. *You might end with Creed, Our Father, Hail Mary, Glory be.*
