The last two weeks of Lent are called Passiontide. During this time all the crucifixes and sacred images are veiled in violet. In Masses of the season, The Psalm *Judica me* is omitted at the Prayers at the Foot of the Altar, and there is no *Gloria Patri* at the *Asperges, Introit, & Lavabo*.
