

In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

CCC #1832 “The fruits of the Spirit **are perfections** that the Holy Spirit forms in us as the first fruits of eternal glory. The tradition of the Church lists twelve of them: “charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity” (Gal. 5:22).

Of the Fruits, St. Thomas Aquinas says... (from his Commentary on Galatians)

Five Fruits perfect man inwardly:

Charity ~ inclines man to the good, “The charity of God is poured forth in our hearts by the Holy Ghost Who is given to us.” (Rm 5:5) Charity perfects all other inward movements: “Above all these things have charity, which is the bond of perfection.” (Col. 3:14)

Joy ~ arises from the presence of the good, the object of love. He that has charity already has what he loves, “He that abides in charity abides in God and God in him.” (1 Jn 4:16); “Rejoice in the Lord always; again, I say, rejoice.” (Phil. 4:4)

Peace ~ the blossom of joy for two reasons: first, the firm union between lover and beloved brings rest, “I am become in his presence as one finding peace.” (Cant. 8:10); second, the enjoyment from the union, whatever else happens, cannot be hindered from being enjoyed, “Much peace have they who love thy law and to them there is no stumbling block.” (Ps. 118:165)

Patience ~ perfects man against evils to the Fruit of Peace, “In your patience you shall possess your souls.” (Lk 21:19)

Long-suffering ~ perfects man against evils which hinder the Fruit of Joy, or those things which delay the presence of the object loved, “If it make any delay, wait for it; for it will surely come, and it shall not be slack.” (Hab 2:3); “He that shall persevere unto the end, he shall be saved.” (Mt 10:22)

Seven Fruits perfect man with regard to external things, in three ways:

In what is beside man: his neighbor

Goodness ~ having a *good-will* toward one’s neighbor.

Generosity ~ sharing of goods (time, talent, possessions) with others.

Mildness ~ being meek towards others when they offend e.g., not seeking revenge.

In what is above man: God

Faithfulness ~ having fidelity to God e.g., the habit of... daily prayers, obedience to the Ten Commandments, practice of the Beatitudes & Gospel precepts...

In what is beneath man: his body

Modesty ~ wholesome deeds & speech e.g., proper behavior & dress, words (jokes)...

Continency ~ having a firmness of mind in presence of base temptations.

Chastity ~ using creatures properly as said of a *well-chastened man*.
