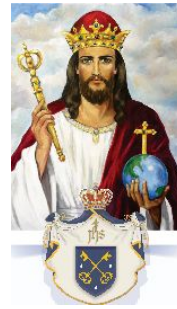

Monday Mass at 7 am.

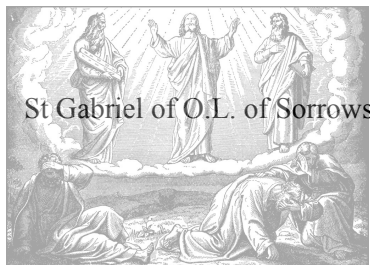
